Kelly Carter has been nanny to our daughter since she was just two months old. She joined us in August 2013 and provided roughly 45 to 50 hours of childcare every week. My wife and I have demanding work schedules that Kelly was able to consistently and reliably accommodate. She kept our daughter safe, happy, and active with a range of age appropriate in-home activities and outings. These included crafts, games, reading, gymnastics, soccer, zoo, aquarium, walks to the nearby parks, and trips to local community centers and libraries. Kelly also coordinated and prepared meals and did laundry and child-related household cleaning.

In November 2015 our new son arrived. Kelly focused on our daughter early on when both of us had some time off, roughly six weeks, but she took over and transitioned well from caring for one to caring for two. Activities and routines shifted, but the adjustment went well for both Kelly and children. They were happy, safe, and engaged in activity.

Kelly was extremely flexible in just about all manners, including cooperatively setting vacation dates with us so we would not have to struggle to find multi-week coverage to accommodate misaligned vacations. She is honest, hardworking, and reliable, and we trusted her with our child (and now children) for years and would have no hesitation doing so again.

We have no reservation whatsoever in recommending Kelly as a nanny.
